


Fig.1B Canopy construction: Push wires through the threaded rod, place check ring, screw threaded rod into the top of the fixture. Follow with the finished pipe, and another check ring. Place canopy onto threaded rod followed by the spider washer and then secure with a nut.




Fig.2 Remove nuts mporary support arms







Fig.5 **Bottom view** Acorn nut on top Regular nut Canopy nuts Long threaded rod (Diffuser) **Finial Ball nuts** below Regular nuts on top of diffuser

1.)Please read before unpacking! When you are unpacking your fixture, please use delicate caution. Remove bags of styrofoam material, be aware that some of the bags may "grab" the copper pins which hold the acrylic tiles together. Pull these bags out carefully. Check as you are unpacking, If any pins are disturbed just bend them back flat. 2.) When unpacking, you need to support the ring that holds the acrylic tiles. We have included temporary support arms to use (Fig.2), while you fix the canopy and support arms to the ceiling. Unscrew the 2x4s' on top of crate, leave the center two connected to fixture! Remove the two (1&2) on the sides of crate. You may use the two center 2x4s' (3&4) to remove fixture from crate (like a stretcher) and onto temporary support arms.(Fig.1&2) 3.)Once fixture is on temp. support arms, remove the center 2x4s' (3&4) from fixture.(Fig.1&2) 4.)Remove the canopy and shade support arms by unscrewing the nuts that hold the shade to the arms.(Fig.2&4) Construct canopy: (Fig.1A & 1B) 5.) Attach ceiling plate to ceiling, SEE WARNING at the top of page!! Bring shade support arms/light cluster to your ceiling plate. Make all electrical connections as per local codes. Slide canopy onto the four bolts pointing down from the ceiling plate. Secure in place with the four canopy nuts.(Fig.3&5) 6.) Take your long threaded rods and secure to the top of the shade using the nuts (under) and acorn nuts (on top) provided.(Fig.5&6) 7.) Bring your ring of tiles to the support arms and

secure to the arms with the four support arm nuts you removed in step 4.(Fig.2,4&6)

8.)You may want to bulb at this time.

9.) Place diffuser: the 8 long threaded rods hanging from the top ring should have a nut on the bottom. Your diffuser should slide onto these rods to meet the regular nut. Secure with the diffuser ball nuts provided. Halfway through ball nut placement: be sure that your center rod from light cluster penetrates the center of your diffuser. Screw your finial onto this rod. Continue with diffuser ball nuts. (Fig.5)
