- 1.)Attach crossbar to ceiling. There should be two bolts pointing down to receive canopy/fixture.(Fig.1)
- 2.)You may attach arms and fixture's oval before or after canopy is secure to ceiling.
- 3.)Raise canopy to ceiling and connect all electrical wires as per your local codes. Slide canopy up onto the two bolts pointing down from crossbar. Secure canopy flush to ceiling with two nuts provided.(Fig.1)
- 4.)Raise fixture oval to an arms length from hub. Run electrical wire from each arm through its corresponding loop. Hook arms onto loops once arm wires are through hub loops, be sure to not pinch wires. (Fig.2)
- 5.)Connect hub wires as per your local codes. You do not need to uncrimp the crimped nuts.(Fig.3)
- 6.)Once hub wires are connected screw your two nipples(Fig.4) into the two hickeys' located inside the hub(Fig.3). Place hub cover up onto the hub and the two nipples should protrude a little through hub cover. Secure cover with the two hub nuts provided.(Fig.4) 7.)Execute step 3 if you have not already. Place candle covers, bulb your fixture (bulbs provided by others). Power on, enjoy your new fixture!
